### **Manuscript preparation**

All manuscripts must be in English typed single-spaced with margins of 2.54 cm all round. The paper should not exceed an equivalent of 12 single-spaced (12 points Times New Roman) pages including Tables and Figures. The following points should be adhered to in the preparation of the manuscript:

*Title, Authors, and Affiliation.* The manuscript should have a cover page containing a clear and concise title; the name(s) and institutional affiliation(s) of author(s). It should also have a complete

mailing address, telephone and fax numbers, and e-mail address of the person to whom all correspondences and proofs should be sent. The next page of the paper should start with the title.

***Abstract:*** Every paper must have an abstract of no more than 150-350 words, covering the objectives of the work, methods used, result obtained and conclusions reached.

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Number tables consecutively with Arabic numerals, and give each a clear descriptive caption at the top.

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
