**SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STAFF THAT PROVIDE KEY LAND MANAGEMENT
FUNCTIONS REQUIRED FOR NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT FOR THE
ACADEMIC YEARS 2023/2024**

1. Makerere University received funding from World-Bank under the Competitive and Enterprise Development Project (CEDP) to support the establishment of a Master of Science in Land Management Program at Makerere University. Part of the funding has been applied to finance a scholarship scheme targeting 10 scholarships in MSc Land Management tenable at Makerere University.
2. Applications will be required from eligible applicants who meet the criteria spelt out for the scholarship. Applicants must be willing to return to their places of work upon completion of their courses where they will improve the quality-of-service delivery. All applicants must not be beneficiaries of any other parallel scholarship.
3. Applications delivered in person by the applicants will be accepted. At the delivery of the application, the applicant will be required to enter his/her name in the register and receive a stamped acknowledgement for reference. Those who will be found to have a running scholarship shall be disqualified.
4. The CEDP – World Bank scholarship for the academic years 2023/2024 will cater for:
 - a. Tuition fees - payable to Makerere University per semester for 2 years.
 - b. Functional fees - payable to Makerere University once in an academic year and will cover: (a) registration fee; (b) examination fee; (c) library fees; (d) development fee; (e) Technology fee; (f) university identity card; (g) rules and caution; and (h) academic gown.

5. Eligibility criteria

a. Basic Requirements

Ugandan nationals who intend to apply for the scholarships must meet the basic criteria below.

- Applicants should have letters of appointment in the land-related position from the Organization at which they work.

- Applicants should have served for a period of not less than 2 years in a relevant field or office;
- Applicants should be citizens of Uganda aged not more than 45 years at the time of application;
- Applicants should have obtained at least a provisional admission letter for MSc Land Management from Makerere University;
- The applicant should acknowledge that they have no other running scholarship, and
- Female candidates are encouraged to apply.

b. Specific requirements

Eligible Ugandans who meet the basic criteria above must in addition provide:

- An application letter;
- Possess the prerequisite certified academic qualifications required to undertake the course MSc Land Management;
- A recommendation letter from the employer;
- A typed motivation letter (not more than 1 page)
- Should have started studying by **28th August 2023**.

6. Submission of Scholarship application letters

- Only applicants that meet the basic and specific criteria shall be required to submit applications.
