





## CALL FOR APPLICATIONS ERASMUS+ KA107-2024 SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS MOBILITY BETWEEN UNIVERSITY OF KASSEL, GERMANY AND MAKERERE UNIVERSITY, KAMPALA, UGANDA. SUMMER SEMESTER ACADEMIC YEARS 2024/25 (APRIL-SEPTEMBER 2025)

The University of Kassel in Germany and Makerere University in Uganda have commenced an EU-funded ERASMUS+ project for Students of the College of Engineering, Design, Art, and Technology under the action KA107 based on the Joint Interinstitutional Agreements. The project aims to promote higher education student and staff mobility to consolidate the institutional relations between the participating universities (University of Kassel and Makerere University) and explore new possibilities for cooperation, training, research, and professional development opportunities as well as establishing and strengthening links between us and the host country to generate beneficial impacts.

Action KA107 will be an excellent opportunity to raise Makerere University's profile and increase cooperation in new geographical areas such as Germany. The project goal is to expand the training and knowledge of the participants as well as to foster the exchange of skills and experiences between the participating countries. Participating staff and students must return to their countries of origin once the mobility period has concluded to put into practice the knowledge acquired and promote the transfer of skills and intercultural liaisons.

To actualize the project and achieve the objective, the project intends to recruit students to participate in the exchange program.

In this regard, the ERASMUS+ KA107 project calls for applications for direct grants for the College of Engineering, Design, Art and Technology students international mobility at Makerere University, under the Erasmus+ KA107 program "Mobility of students between programme and partner countries". This call aims for 2 (Two) Masters Student for 5 (five) months of learning mobility, during the Summer Semester of the Academic Year 2024-2025 (April-September 2025)

The deadline for application is the 4th of November 2023.

## **Features of The Mobility for outgoing Students:**

- Only applicants from the College of Engineering Design, Art and Technology on normal progress will be considered and shall be students at the time of the exchange,
- Mobility studies will be aimed at those studying Master subjects taught at the university in the fields of: Groundwater Reactive Transport Modeling, Resource management and solid waste engineering, Hydrological Research Seminar, Modelling and Simulation of Wastewater Treatment Processes, Climate Systems analysis, Analysis, Evaluation and Design of Waste-Resource Systems,
- They must have knowledge of English language proficiency required, as given in the section "Award criteria for the grant".
- For study mobilities of 5(five) months per type of qualification (master's). The maximum grant for the stay will be 5(five) months.
