Position Overview:

As a Graduate Fellow in Stained Glass and Mosaic Art, you will play a supportive role in the teaching and learning, in collaborating with the experts and researchers. Your responsibilities will encompass:

- Assist in preparation of teaching materials, interact directly with students in the studio; conduct practical and tutorial sessions
- Assist in grading papers
- Assist in supervising undergraduate students' projects in Stained Glass and Mosaic Art
- Assist in providing academic guidance and counseling to undergraduate students
- Actively participate in research at the Department
- Execute any other additional responsibilities as may be assigned by the Head of Department.

Qualifications and Eligibility:

- Enrolled in a Masters in Fine Art or a Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) program in Fine Art at Makerere University
- Has a strong foundation in visual-artistic and visual scientific approaches to Stained Glass and Mosaic Art
- Has a Bachelor of Industrial and Fine Art (at least an Upper Second Class) and a Master of Arts in Fine Art
- Possesses excellent problem-solving skills and a creative approach to arts-based research
- Shall not be more than 35 years old for Masters Fellow or 45 years old for PhD Fellow at the time of recruitment
