Course Content:

The content will include:

- Introduction to GIS Definition of GIS, Why GIS is hot, Applications of GIS, Spatial Data Types (Vector data, Raster data), Coordinate Systems and Map projections, QGIS (Layout, Plugins)
- Working with vector and raster data Projection systems (overview of projection support, specifying a projection system, define on the fly (OTF) projection, Vector data Models (Importing vector data, vector properties dialogue), Raster Data Models (Importing raster data, Raster properties dialogue)
- Spatial data analysis basics Geo-referencing, Digitizing, Topology Checking, GPS data collection (Field procedures, GPS data download, Importing GPS data), Coordinate capture and layer creation.
- Introduction to Spatial / Geodatabases Keys, integrity Constraints, Conceptual, logical, Physical data models, relational, network, object oriented, Object Oriented Relational, Hierarchical data structures.
- **Spatial Data Acquisition Techniques** Spatial Selection Queries (Objects and table connections, Query builder), Vector Geo-processing (Clipping, Difference, Intersection, Union, Buffers), Raster Geo-processing (DEM extraction, Contour extraction, Slope extraction, Raster Calculation).
- **GIS data Visualization** Map preparation and Cosmetics, Map printing.
